

# Cannon Wreck Project

The Cannon Wreck Project is Gold Hound's latest project to get underway. We began this project in 2008 by conducting a high resolution magnetometer survey of the site. We covered several hundred linear miles dragging the magnetometer back and forth across the wreck site detecting hundreds of magnetic anomalies or targets. We began identifying these anomalies in 2009. What we found so far is that it appears that there is more than one wreck in this area. Our mission on this wreck site is to continue to identify each and every target to try and help identify which ship or what part of the ship the cannon wreck really is.

Over the years there have been magnificent discoveries on this site with the most recent being over \$1,000,000 in gold jewelry and jewel studded rings. Another amazing discovery was made in the early nineties when a treasure salvor recovered 39 beautiful eight escudos and hundreds of silver coins.

With our technology we have been able to locate new debris trails which we believe may hold more magnificent treasures. It is now only a matter of time!
